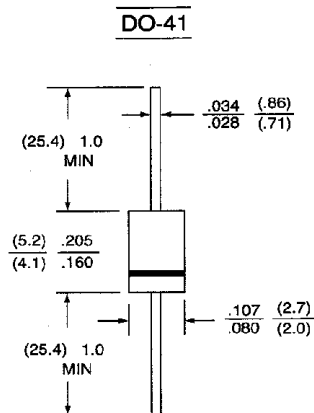

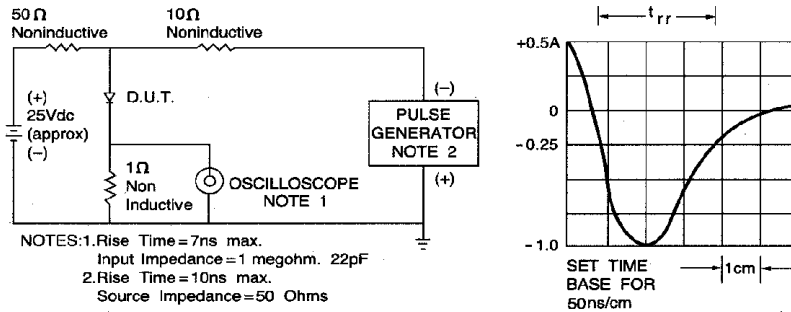


Fig. 1 - REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC AND TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM

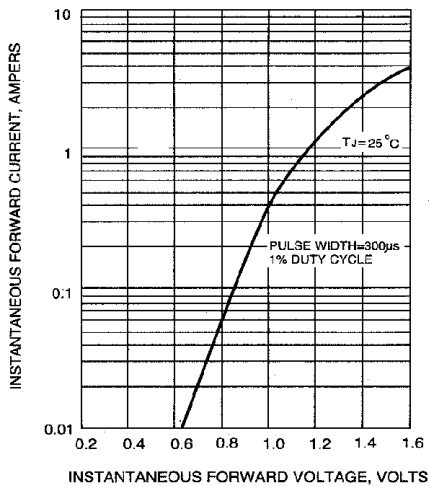


Fig. 2 - TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

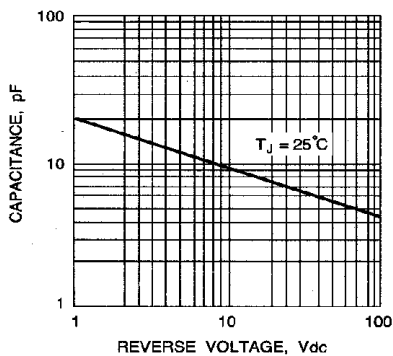


Fig. 4 - TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

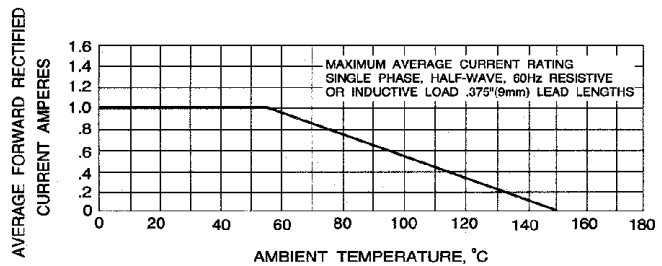


Fig. 3 - FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

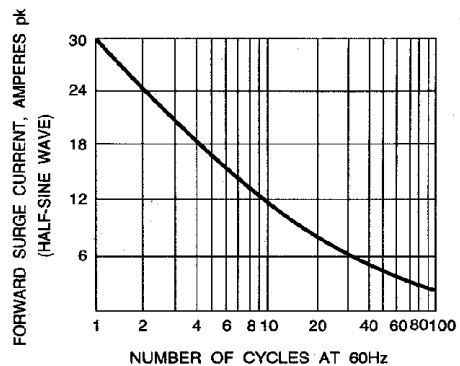


Fig. 5 - PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

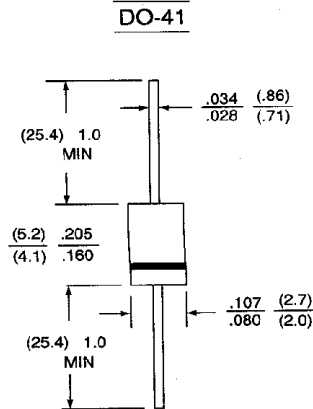

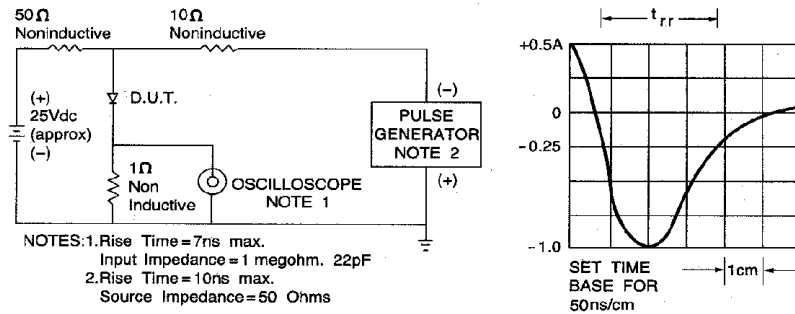


Fig. 1 - REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC AND TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM

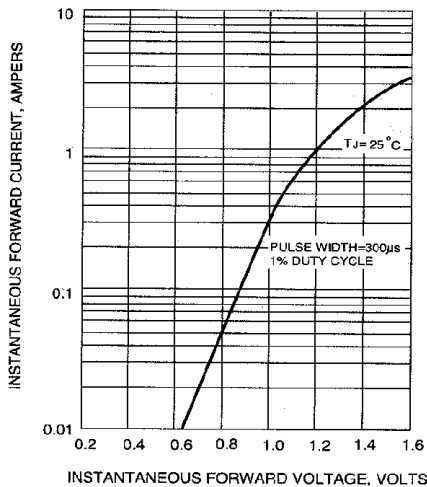


Fig. 2 - TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

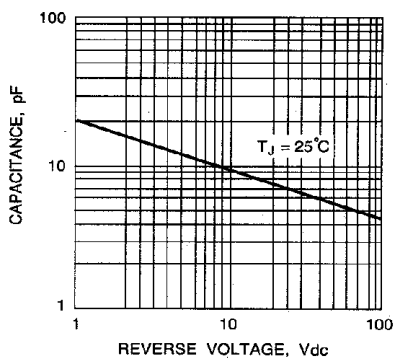


Fig. 4 - TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

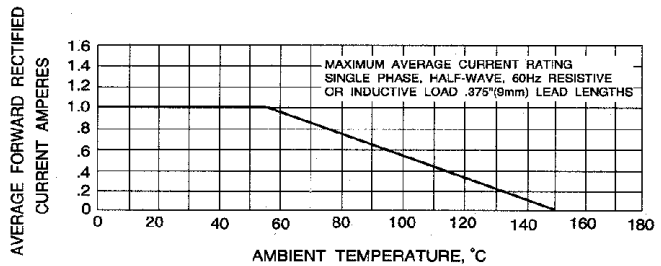


Fig. 3 - FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

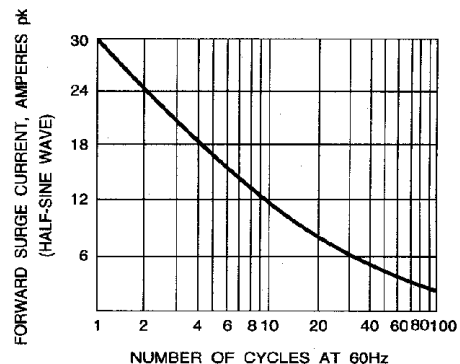


Fig. 5 - PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT
